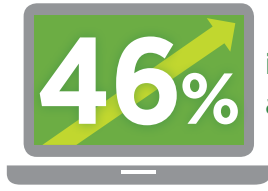
## 24-HOUR HOTLINE & INTERVENTION

We operate a 24-hour hotline, providing intervention services, and Community Center for drop-in appointments. Women and men experiencing sexual or domestic abuse can receive immediate crisis management services including safety planning, counseling, and assistance to receive medical, legal, and other services.

## SHELTER PROGRAMS

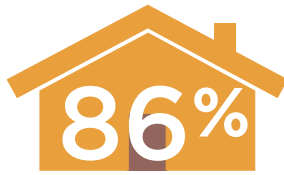
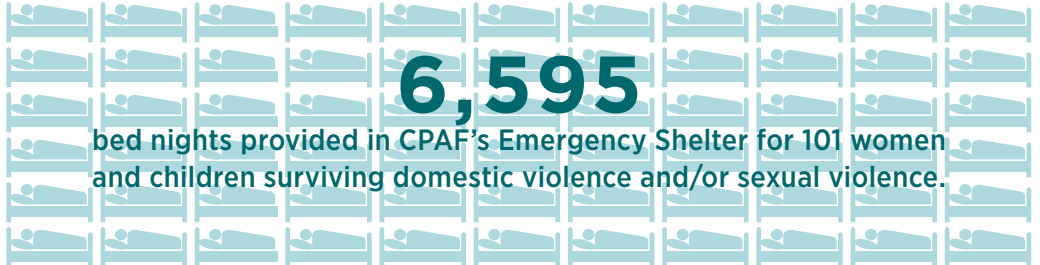
CPAF's shelters are safe, confidential facilities for women and children fleeing domestic violence.

**Emergency Shelter**

At our 45-bed shelter, we provide basic needs, counseling and supportive services. Families can stay up to six months.

**Transitional Shelter**

At our 7-unit facility, families can stay for up to 12 months. We provide counseling, job search help and free childcare.



**86%** of Transitional Shelter program graduates moved into permanent housing and/or increased their income.

## COMMUNITY SERVICES

We focus on community engagement and violence prevention programs, and conduct outreach to raise awareness about domestic violence and sexual assault. We partner with community-based organizations to deepen violence prevention strategies with API youth and develop community-centered, innovative healing groups for sexual assault survivors.

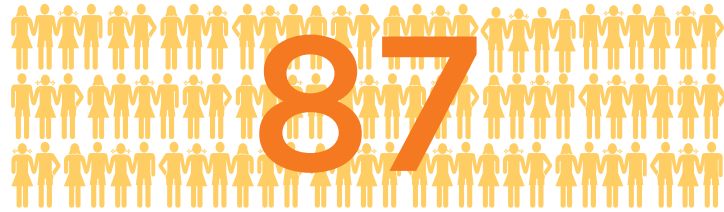

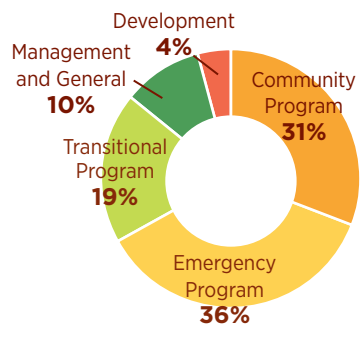
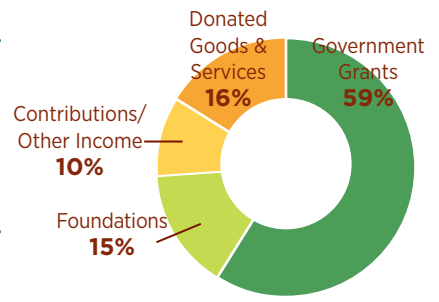
