Many clients experienced financial abuse, and gift cards are one way to support them on their journey toward empowerment and financial independence. Flexible gift cards like Visa or Mastercard provide the means to establish independence while developing a new, safe household for themselves and their children. Suggested amount range is \$10-100/card, and the most common amount donated per card is \$20-50.</p>
