CPAF answered 3,703 calls on its 24-hour domestic violence and sexual assault hotline in 25 different languages.

LOVE 117 survivors and children received

31 survivors and children received transitional program services; 100% maintained or increased their income, and 80% moved into safe and permanent housing after graduating from the program.





